Course Description

The congress brings together some of the most expert otolaryngologists in Europe, who report their personal and school experience, in the light of data from the scientific literature updated in three major topics of our specialty. The first session analyzes the application of robotic surgery in the field of head and neck oncology, with particular emphasis and comparison with non-surgical therapy, the outcomes obtained and the patient's quality of life.

The second session focuses on the most innovative topics in diagnosis and treatment options of sleep-disordered breathing, including the application of artificial intelligence in this field. Finally, the third session addresses the latest updates on surgical, corticosteroid and biological therapy for chronic rhinosinusitis with polyposis.

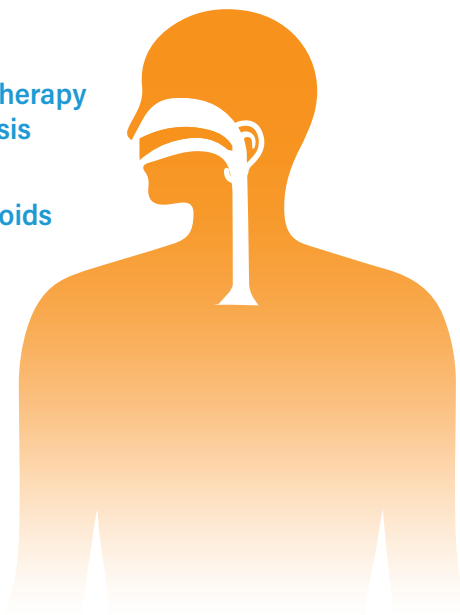
