# **Course Description**

The first session analyzes the application of robotic surgery in the field of head and neck oncology, with particular emphasis and comparison with non-surgical therapy, the outcomes obtained and the patient's quality of life.

The second session focuses on the most innovative topics in diagnosis and treatment options of sleep-disordered breathing, including the application of artificial intelligence in this field. Finally, the third session addresses the latest updates on surgical, corticosteroid and biological therapy for chronic rhinosinusitis with polyposis.
